International Protective Security Board Announces EP Shooting Challenge for 2017 Close Protection Conference



The International Protective Security Board (IPSB), which will host its 2nd annual Close Protection Conference in Las Vegas from November 30th - December 2 at the Westgate Hotel, has announced an open invitation to participate in the first annual EP Shooting Challenge.

The 2017 EP Shooting Challenge is being organized by Method Enterprises and will be hosted by the IPSB and Advanced Protection Institute in Boulder City, NV. The event will take place the day before the conference on November 29th, from 9:00am – 2:00pm at The Pro Gun Club.

This is an everyday carry/work pistol challenge (No Competition Pistols!). Holsters should completely cover trigger guard and be secured along the waistline & strong side (No Cross Draw or Shoulder Holsters) Bring at least 4 magazines, extra mag holder, and 200 rounds of ammunition.

For participants that are not able to bring their own firearms, there will be 10 Glocks, mags and holsters available for rent through API. Ammunition can be purchased at The Pro Gun Club Pro Shop.

The competition will not only act as a networking opportunity for conference members but will help support the IPSB's aim of furthering knowledge and best practices as this event is designed to mimic the real-life scenarios that may be encountered by Executive Protection agents as well as other members of the security industry.
